Building Works

Early building works on the car park at the Clarence Community Health Centre were completed in late March.

The successful tenderer for the main building works will be announced as soon as new Minister(s) for Health & Human Services are in place. The Development Application is with Clarence City Council for consideration at their 26 April meeting, with building works set to begin in May 2010 pending Council approval.

GP Super Clinic

Nominations for Directors for the Clarence GP Super Clinic foundation Board have been received.

A preliminary meeting of the group will take place in April with the first formal board meeting in May.

The first task of the board will be to ensure the development of the tender documentation for the recruitment of a provider of medical practice services.
