


This fact sheet gives you important information about the general use and care of a bathboard. It describes how to install, use and care for a bathboard.

This fact sheet does not replace specific instructions given to you by the equipment prescriber.

Requirements for a bathboard

A bathboard can provide a safe way for a person to get in and out of a shower over the bath, however they do not fit all baths. There may be other assistive technology (equipment) available if your bath is not suitable.




Things to check:

- 1. There must be a flat surface on each side of the bath for the bathboard to rest on (A in diagram). This should be at least 30mm.
- 2. The inside of the bath must be wide enough to allow the bathboard feet to fit securely when adjusted (B in diagram).

Fitting the bathboard

- I. Loosen the bathboard feet by turning anti-clockwise.
- Place bathboard on the bath. Place near a handle on wall (if fitted).
- 3. Tighten bathboard feet by turning clockwise.
- 4. Test that the bathboard is secure before using.








Using the bathboard

- 1. Stand at edge of bath with your back towards bathboard. You should feel the bath with the back of your legs.
- 2. Sit on bathboard as far back as you can.
- 3. Lift your legs into bath one at a time, holding the handle (if fitted).



Care of the bathboard

- Clean the bathboard with warm water and a mild soap.
- The bathboard has a weight limit of 150kg.
- The bathboard has a temperature limit between negative 3 degrees Celsius and 70 degrees Celsius.
