

OUR HISTORY



Dr. William Prout Holman established a medical practice in Tasmania in 1925 which laid the foundation for the creation of the state's first cancer centre in Launceston. His vision was to create a cancer centre where humanity, care and compassion, service and the delivery of state-of-the-art cancer treatments shared equal importance.

In 1957, the Peter MacCallum Cancer Clinic in Melbourne officially opened a satellite centre in Launceston. The Tasmanian Government assumed responsibility for this service in 1986 and the centre was fittingly renamed the W.P. Holman Clinic, in memory of its founder.
